

# I'm Leaving LoDebar

Scriptures: 2 Samuel 4:4, 2 Samuel 9:1-13; Ephesians 2:4-7

## WHAT IS LODEBAR?

- No pasture, the place of nothing,
- Contrast Lo-Debar with what the Word says God has for you and I  
Psa. 23:2, Eze. 34:13-15; Deut. 28:1-6; Rev. 7:17

## WHY DO WE STAY IN LODEBAR?

- FEAR:
  - Fear of the unknown – Gen. 12
  - Fear of the known – Mat. 14: 21-28
    - Fear of giants (Lack of faith, Low self-esteem) – Num. 13
    - Fear of what others will think – Psa. 56:11; Psa. 118:6
  - Fear of failure
    - I must realize that there is no failure in God – Isa. 55:11
    - I can't let a set-back stop me from trusting God – Rom. 8:28; Psa. 138:8
  - Fear of challenge – Exo. 14:11-12
- THE EVENT:
  - God allowed it, yet the devil seeks to use it to destroy you – Job 1: 8-12;

## I'M LEAVING LODEBAR

- Leaving with God's favor – 2 Sam. 9: 1
- Leaving because of covenant relationship – 2 Sam. 9: 1
- God has prepared a seat for me at the table – 2 Sam. 9: 11
- My physical condition doesn't limit my potential – 2 Sam. 9: 12

## SERMON POINTS

- **You may not be able to walk like others, but, if you ever make up in your mind to leave LoDebar, God will lead you to the place of blessing... Gen. 12:1-2**
- **My potential is not stopped by my scars – my scars prove my potential!! John 20:27**
