

Moving What Seems Unmovable

Key #1: Nothing Is Impossible with God

- God is not short on time – Psa. 90:1-2
- God is not lacking in power and ability – Isa. 40:21-27
- God has not changed. If He did it then, He can do it now – Mal. 3:6; John 14:12; Heb. 13:8

Key #2: Never Seen Does Not Mean Impossible

- Ecc. 1:9; Isa. 43:19; Jer. 31:22

Key #3: Does God Want It Moved?

- Is my timing right? 1 Pet. 5:6-11
- Does God want me to do this? 1 Sam. 30:8
- Is God using it to develop me?
 - In faith – 1 Pet. 1:7; James 1:2
 - In character and so much more – 2 Pet. 1:4-8
- How will I know? 1 Cor. 10:13-14 (MSG); Gal. 5:7

Key #4: Why Do You Want It Moved?

- Is it for God's glory or mine? Heb. 11:24-26; 1 Pet. 3:12-17

Key #5: You Must Move Before It Will Ever Budge

- Mat. 21:21
- Where is your diligence? Heb. 11:6
- James 2:17-26
- You must change your perspective on what you are facing – 1 Sam. 17:26

Key #6: How Does God Know You Really Want It Moved?

- Haven't seen such faith...Mat. 8:10; Luke 7:9
- Mat. 15:22-28
- Heb. 11:6
 - Are you being diligent about seeking God or are you just being casual?

Key #7: Is there a Word from God?

- Jer. 1:12; Isa. 55:11
